

Benefits of Pac/SE Asia Rallies

- Briefings for new cruisers / new cruising area
- Paperwork assistance on the front end
 - Reduced bond/agent help in French Polynesia
 - Help with visas and cruising permits in Indonesia/Malaysia
- Security
 - Military escorts in sketchy area N Borneo
- Radio Nets & help when underway and...

More Benefits of Pac/SE Asia Rallies

- Arrival help (customs/immigration, fuel, water)
- Free tours & cultural experiences
- English-speaking officials & guides
- Free fuel in Indonesia




Some Downsides of Rallies

- A lot of boats going the same way at the same time
 - Sometimes crowded anchorage
 - Sometimes struggling for limited resources
 - Sometimes Cliquey behavior
- Dangers of the "Pack Mentality"
- Sometimes on a schedule

– A lot depends on who organizes the rally

The Round the World Rally

- Large cost (~\$30K)
- Huge hand-holding at destination spots
- Lots of sea miles, not much "cruising"
- See the world in 24 months

Cruising Rallies – Western Atlantic

- Transatlantic: WCC ARC and Cornell Sailing Atlantic and Caribbean Odyssey
- Seasonal to and from Caribbean:
 - Salty Dawg: Fall (Southbound) and Spring Rallies
 - World Cruising Club Carib 1500 and USA Rallies
 - NARC Fall Rally to Bermuda
- Cuba Rallies:
 - Salty Dawg, American Sailing Association, Cruising World
 - Other organizations.
- Other:
 - NARC Rally to the Cup 2017
 - World Cruising Club DelMarVa Rally
 - Salty Dawg Rally to Maine

Benefits of Atlantic Rallies

- Weather and Routing Support (e.g. Chris Parker with SaltyDawgs)
- Organized tracking and radio nets
- Pre-Departure social and educational events
- Technical support from experienced sailors
- Discounts on purchases and dockage from sponsors
- Logistical support where to start and where to go
- Network of like-minded sailors
 - Network of kid boats

Potential Pitfalls of Rallies

- Group-think on departures and destinations
- Cost (can vary significantly)
- May be easy to stay amongst sailors with similar backgrounds and experiences – Do you limit your cultural experience?
- Artificially inflated sense of safety in numbers
- Sometimes:
 - rigid schedules
 - Submission to someone else's idea of proper safety gear
